2012 Annual Report

South Sound Recovery Services provides recovery services for those who struggle with alcohol or other chemical dependency. These services include but are not limited to intervention, assessment, counseling, mentoring, and referral. Services are provided by volunteer counselors and drug addiction specialists. Volunteers also provide telephone support to clients. Our clients for these services are often financially disadvantaged and not eligible for assistance from other organizations.

We partner with other organizations that foster abstinence from abuse of alcohol or other mind-altering chemicals. Our clients are referred by other clients, local law enforcement, the Department of Corrections, various self-help groups, and local mental health services.

Through private donations and an Agency Grant from the United Way of Mason County, we were able provide emergency food packages to many clients who were hit hard by the poor economy. We provided Thanksgiving and Christmas meals to our clients and their families and gave Christmas presents to children of client families. We distributed a clothing package consisting of two t-shirts and three pairs socks to each of the approximately 120 inmates in the Mason County Jail. We provided new socks for those inmates who suffer from diabetes and entered custody during the year. We also provided 139 pairs of reading glasses for the inmates.

All program services were provided with no labor costs to the organization through volunteer efforts. The table below identifies some of our activities performed that benefit not only the individuals served but also the community itself as we help those who struggle become whole and contributing members of our local society.

Funding and Fiscal Responsibility

It is the full intention of South Sound Recovery to wisely and appropriately use any funding provided either by direct contribution or grant. In our first year of operation, our total administrative expenses consisted of State and Federal filing fees and a small fee from our bank. From 2004 until 2010, our only administrative expenses were only our annual corporate filing fees and charity registration fees to the Secretary of State. More than 99% of expenditures went directly to fund program activities. This year we had additional administrative expenses but still were able to devote nearly 95% of our funds to meet program costs. All listed client and professional services and management are provided without labor expense to the organization.
